Requires specific knowledge of standard and high definition digital video systems as well as familiarity with digital audio systems including AES, Dolby Digital (AC-3) and Dolby E (5.1+2). The ideal candidate is required to have excellent interpersonal communication skills, and be keenly observant and detail oriented. Knowledge and familiarity with standard and high definition digital video systems is expected. Requirements also include demonstrated computer competency including a working knowledge of Microsoft operating systems, Outlook, Word and Excel is required.
